Green Team: Your congregation will need to form a team of persons dedicated to reducing the energy usage of your building(s) and encouraging other sustainable activities. OhIPL can work with your congregation to help develop this team.

Energy Stewards® online software: Created specifically for houses of worship, this online program helps your congregation to benchmark your utility use. OhIPL can assist you in the initial data entry and setup. The online platform allows you to compare your usage with that of other congregations. Energility, an energy management firm, provides bi-monthly educational webinars for congregations participating in Energy Stewards.

Walk-through Energy Assessment: If appropriate for your congregation, OhIPL can lead your team in a walk-through of your facility to review existing energy consuming equipment and identify low and no cost energy savings options that can quickly be implemented. The walk-through may also help to identify potential capital projects.

Detailed Energy Audit: If indicated by the Walk-through Energy Assessment, a Level 2 Energy Assessment can be implemented to study capital projects. This is a detailed engineering study, providing a full economic analysis of the projects. Your congregation will need to budget for and implement this audit. OhIPL can assist your congregation in selecting a qualified engineer for the work and accessing potential rebates for the assessment.

* We recommend that congregations continue with the Energy Stewards program for at least two years to obtain the fullest benefit.
